Course Description

This course focuses on an area called meta-ethics, the discussion of the nature of ethics. It examines the reflective activity about ethics and the rights and wrongs of particular issues within ethics. The course discusses the nature of moral value: descriptive content, the existence of moral properties, its relation to human beings, by category, properties, and nature of normative authority. Lecture topics include ethical intuitionism; the emotive meaning of ethical terms; morality as a system of hypothetical imperatives; inventing right and wrong; and a Darwinian dilemma. Assessment: papers, final exam, attendance and participation.
