Course Description

This course focuses on analyzing the responses of Japan and the global community to multiple environmental issues, predominantly climate change, biodiversity loss, and desertification. The special focus is on Japan's ambition to actively engage in climate change negotiations and the path to reaching carbon neutrality by 2050. The latter is a crucial step to maximize the chances that the average temperature warming will not exceed 1.5°C above the preindustrial average. The course also explores what Japan has been doing to tackle climate change and other environmental issues.
