This course mainly focuses on romantic relationships. The course reviews historical and classic approaches to studying intimate relationships as well as new research to better understand real-world relationship functioning. General topics include attachment, attraction, social cognition, commitment, love, sexuality, conflict, and maintaining high-quality relationships, as well as breaking up and being single. The course explores questions such as: Why are relationships so important to us? What informs our choice of friends and romantic partners? What predicts satisfaction and stability in relationships? How can we become better romantic partners? And what predicts wellbeing in singlehood?
