Course Description

This course introduces the creative and mysterious world of the venture capital (VC) and private equity(PE) investments. This course brings in the latest and most used VC/PE investment methodologies and practical tools from Silicon Valley, the heart of the global VC/PE industry. It starts with investigating the overall ecosystem and relationship between start-ups, VC's, and Fund of Funds. Then it picks up the practical tools on the legal framework, organizational structures, funding channels and types, pre and post-money valuation methodologies, and pipeline generation. The course takes a deep dive into the exiting strategies including M&A, roadshow preparation, IPO, (Leveraged) Buyout, secondary market sales, and final LP/GP distributions. Throughout the course, students track the current start ups and VC/PE funding rounds as they happen and cross-reference these real life deals with the tools and methodologies delivered in this course.
