Course Description

The course examines the "general part" of criminal law and selected areas of the special part of criminal law in the context of theories of the aims and functions of criminalization. The course discusses the limits to criminalization; the conceptual framework of criminal liability (conduct, responsibility, capacity, defenses); homicide; sexual offences; non-fatal violence against the person; property offences (with particular reference to theft, fraud, robbery and burglary); secondary participation in crime; inchoate offences; and regulatory offences.
