Course Description

In this course, students study autism spectrum disorder, a neurodevelopmental condition, across all stages of the lifespan – from early childhood into old age. The course focuses on cognition, while contextualizing the condition at different stages of development. Students explore areas in childhood and adolescence, including memory, language, learning, the "self," mental health, and transgender issues. Students also examine adulthood topics including Bayesian theories of perception, maternal autism, memory, sensory, and emotional processing. The course finishes with addressing some of the consequences of ageing in autism.
