This French language course is for students at the intermediate level who have completed level A2. Learning objectives and methodology include linguistic support; methodological support; and cultural input through the documents studied in class. The communication objectives include talking about simple cultural differences; explaining the main points of an idea or event with sufficient accuracy; giving a simple presentation on a familiar topic and answer questions related to the chosen topic; identifying the main ideas in various types of everyday documents; understanding the important points of an exchange in clear, standard language on familiar topics encountered in your environment; and writing simple, coherent texts on a range of varied topics. It utilizes language tools such as the present tense (to describe, express a fact or an opinion); past tenses; expressing the future; questions; expressing cause, effect, and purpose; and prepositions of place and time.
