This course helps establish a concept of classroom management, so as to benefit students when dealing with the issues arising from the interactions between teachers, students and parents that they will directly face in the teaching field. In the "Teacher Professional Development Assessment" currently implemented by the Ministry of Education in primary and secondary schools, classroom management indicators account for a significant proportion (6-1. Creating a positive and interactive classroom atmosphere, 6-2. Creating a safe and conducive learning environment, 6-3. Establishing classroom routines that facilitate student learning, etc.). Each sub-indicator emphasizes classroom vision, routines, cohesion, positive communication, learning environment, handling unexpected events, and the ability to provide respectful and differentiated guidance.
