Course Description

This course offers a thematic approach to Greek archaeology, examining the material foundations of daily, civic, military, religious, and cultural life in the ancient Greek world. Topics include the archaeology of the city, warfare, death and funerary practices, spectacle, trade and exchange, and sanctuaries. Through the study of urban plans, domestic and public architecture, and major monumental complexes, students gain insight into how Greek societies were structured and organized from the Archaic to the Hellenistic periods. Emphasis is placed on developing the ability to read and interpret archaeological plans, understand spatial organization, and compare key sites across the Greek world within a solid chronological framework.
