This course introduces the essential tools and frameworks of sustainable finance and impact investing. Drawing on cutting-edge research from LSE's Department of Finance, students navigate the complexities of responsible investing and understand where investors and industry need to focus to support the transition to a more sustainable economy.

Focusing on two key areas, the course equips students to analyze how sustainable finance and impact investing create value while also developing the skills to lead organizational change toward more sustainable practices.
