Course Description

Can Turkey's internal contradictions prevent it from fulfilling its ambition to become a major power? Although it remains weakened by certain internal divisions, Turkey seems to be successfully transforming itself on the international stage, moving from the status of a marginal power to that of a regional power. This course analyzes the drivers of this transformation, asking how far this ambition could take Ankara, between disenchantment (falling into line) and real change (global influence). The course covers essential knowledge about Turkey and its place in the new global order; builds critical analysis and synthesis skills by confronting sometimes opposing ideas or divergent opinions (e.g., by studying texts that present different points of view on the same subject); and practices constructing, producing, and writing a press article.
