The course examines the interrelationship between humans and nature, with a particular emphasis on how social power relations produce and change socio-physical conditions. The course starts from the premise that nature and society are not separate, but intimately interwoven. They are mutually intertwined and co-evolving. The course draws on a variety of critical theoretical perspectives (Marxist, post-Marxist, feminist, post-colonial) and illustrates the argument with a series of case studies.
