Course Description

This course offers a multidimensional introduction to the global poverty challenge, examining how poverty is defined, measured, and addressed within the framework of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Students explore poverty's intersection with global risks such as education disparities, gender inequality, migration, climate change and skills development among others. The course encourages students to investigate real-world poverty reduction projects by international organizations and features projects by the World Bank, UNESCO, etc. to address poverty in the areas of education and skills development.

Students should expect to form groups and lead a session at a hypothetical international conference titled: "Global Conference on Poverty Solutions: Linking Practice and Evidence." Each group will be responsible for organizing a panel discussion session to highlight a project implemented by international organizations to address global poverty among other goals. Students will also write a policy brief based on international organizations' projects or research related to poverty reduction.
