Course Description

This course uses an integrated, multidisciplinary approach to explore current Community and Public Health challenges, focusing on both global and local issues in the Dominican Republic. The curriculum is structured around a critical examination of Environmental and Social Determinants of Health (ESDOH), emphasizing the ways in which culture, governance, climate change, human mobility, equity, justice, and inclusion influence health outcomes across diverse communities. Students develop non-clinical research skills to identify community health gaps and develop evidence-based, culturally sensitive, and sustainable interventions.
