Course Description

This course explores the parasitic infections of humans and how parasites gain access to, and survive within, their hosts. Parasites studied include Plasmodium (the malaria causing parasite), African and South American trypanosomes, Toxoplasma, hookworm, and Schistosomes. This course provides an understanding of the molecular and cellular interactions underpinning the functional interactions between animal parasites and their hosts, and introduces the scope and relevance of parasitism in terms of parasite biology and human and animal disease.
