This course introduces students to psychological theories of prejudice, discrimination, and intergroup relations, with a strong emphasis on applying these theories to multi-ethnic and racial contexts in various parts of the world (e.g., the UK, US, Turkey). Students consider key issues in the study of intergroup relations in reference to perceptions and experiences of majority and minority group members as well as classic and contemporary theory and research on prejudice and intergroup relations. The applications of such theory and research to pressing social issues (e.g., racism, sexism, ageism) are also discussed.
