Course Description

This course explores the relationship between language, society, and culture from a sociolinguistic and intercultural perspective. It identifies how social, historical, and cultural factors influence language use and variation, as well as the processes of language contact. This course addresses the impact of intercultural communication on identity, social interaction, and the construction of meanings. It begins with a brief history and the fundamental concepts of sociolinguistics and then moves to the types of variation in sociolinguistics. Next, it concentrates on the relationship between language and attitude and then that of language and culture. This course examines culture and intercultural communication and finishes by discussing the future of English as a global language.
