This course introduces students to major concepts and debates in a humanist approach to climate change and examines a range of existing solutions to the crisis.

The first part of the course, “The Politics of Climate Change,” introduces students to major concepts and debates in a critical approach to climate change, considering the origins of climate change and its intersection with economic and social inequality. The second unit of the course, “Climate Justice in Practice,” examines a range of existing solutions to climate change, considering their advantages, drawbacks, and tactics for implementation.
