Course Description

This course is part of the Laurea Magistrale degree program and is intended for advanced level students. Enrollment is by permission of the instructor. This course covers topics on currency, liquidity, and balance of payment crises as well as international financial contagion. Issues pertaining to monetary/financial, exchange rate, in connection with the antecedents and aftermath of crises are studied at both the theoretical and empirical level. It is an advanced course that builds on the standard intertemporal small open economy models with frictions such as imperfect capital markets, intertemporal distortions, and non-tradable goods and applies these theoretical tools to study in detail specific topics inspired by recent events such as financial crises, the global role of the dollar, and the economic effects of the covid virus.
