Course Description

Several environmental, personal, and biological factors appear to be important for healthy socio-emotional development, but occasionally these influences can lead to problem behavior. The course focuses on the development of problem behavior during childhood and adolescence, how it originates, and how it can be treated as it poses a risk for further healthy development. Topics addressed are the influence of genes/neurobiology, personality, the child's environment (peer interaction, parent attachment/parenting style) on socio-emotional, and moral development and the development of psychopathology such as anxiety, depression, suicide, and narcissism. The final assessment for this course is a numerical grade between 0,0 and 10,0.
