Course Description

This course explores the reconstruction efforts in coastal Fukushima following the 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake, Tsunami, and Nuclear Accident. It emphasizes the roles of local communities and emerging industries. Through field visits to Futaba Town in Fukushima, the class analyzes the impacts of the disaster; understands reconstruction challenges, and develops multidisciplinary problem-solving skills. The course fosters empathy, equipping international and domestic students to learn together and addressing town-building challenges from a global perspective.
