Course Description

The course deals with some basic themes, concepts, and thinkers in international relations. The purpose is to provide students with essential conceptual and linguistic tools for understanding the underlying structure and fundamental features of international politics, as well as its material and immaterial changing aspects. The objective is to explain the dynamics through which men and women understand international politics as well as on achieving a coherent capacity of thinking international life, both in its theoretical and practical dimension. The course examines the most important theories of international politics and foreign policy, with a particular focus on constructivism, liberalism, and realism. Students also study some key concepts of international relations such as the balance of power, hegemony, war, and cooperation.
