Course Description

This course develops a critical and diverse reading of cities by using theoretical and practical resources and studying them from multiple angles (historical, social, political, cultural). It focuses on urban forms and their meanings, considers the main actors in developing the city, and thinks of how to transform the structures of inequality to create more inclusive, equitable, and sustainable cities. This course explores the complexity and diversity that define a city and urban development in Spain and also discusses the urban landscapes of power and capital, urban conflicts, and citizen response to the neoliberal city. It examines how public space, art, and community are approached as an opportunity for change, and it looks at alternative governance and political innovation.
