Course Description

At the end of the course, the student has acquired knowledge of the romance languages and literatures of the Middle Ages and their formation, with particular regard to French and Occitan. The student acquires the skills for adopting the instruments of textual criticism, in order to be aware of the transformations of texts and languages through the centuries. The course content is divided into 3 parts:

I. **Linguistics:** From Latin to the Romance languages (phonetics, morphosyntax, lexicon); The Romance languages across space and time; Characteristics of Gallo-Romance, with particular reference to Old French and Old Occitan.

II. **Textual Criticism:** The concept of textual tradition; The manuscript; Elements of textual editing.

III. **Literary History:** Origins of Romance literatures; Comparative history of the literatures of langue d'oc and langue d'oïl: genres and texts (hagiography, epic, lyric, romance, tale, allegorical-didactic literature); Elements of metrics.
