Course Description

This course is to provide a deep understanding of Organizational Behavior (OB) and its role in fostering effective work environments. Explore how human behavior in organizations is shaped by individual capabilities and workplace relationships, gaining insights into the psychological foundations that distinguish OB from human resource management. The course focuses on applying OB theory to workplace behavior, with particular attention to the South African context, and encourages students to critically reflect on their own professional interactions. This course is restricted to students in their second academic year of study (AYOS). The course is intended for students majoring in Industrial and Organizational Psychology, but students from other streams/faculties may choose this course as an elective.

Assessment: Coursework 60% (assignments, tests). Final examination 40%.
