## Course Description

This course examines intelligence through a progressive structure—classic foundations → frontier intersections → societal applications. While preserving core psychometric frameworks (e.g., *g* and hierarchical models, reliability/validity, standardisation), the course strengthens three frontier strands: cognitive neuroscience, cross-cultural comparison and measurement fairness, and AI in relation to human intelligence. Students will learn to evaluate claims about intelligence using rigorous measurement reasoning and to translate theory into practice across applied settings (education and selection, health/ageing and special populations, and assessment governance in the AI era).
