Course Description

This course covers major topics in the Western study of Classics. In addition to the civilizations of ancient Greece and Rome, this course will cover developments in the study of Ancient Egypt, Mesopotamia, India, and China. It presents an introduction to the major themes and methods involved in the study of the ancient world. Drawing on scholarship in the fields of literature, archaeology, history, and manuscript studies, the course engages with the main theoretical and methodological advances in classics. Using case studies from the ancient world, the course opens perspectives for the comparative study of ancient cultures, and provides a helpful starting point in developing a well-rounded understanding of the classical traditions of the ancient world.
