Course Description

The course examines the financial decisions and strategies of multinational companies operating in international markets. Topics include foreign exchange markets, currency risk and hedging, financial forecasting, capital structure and long-term financing decisions, and the use of derivatives such as forwards, futures, and options. Students also explore international payment methods, multinational cash management, transfer pricing, and the effects of interest rates, inflation, and exchange-rate movements on international business. Case studies are used to analyze financial challenges and decision-making in multinational firms.
